

# Trail Amenities

A user's experience on a trail can be enhanced with amenities that provide comfort as well as memorable experiences.

Alta's designers can create trail features that reflect your city's unique culture and provide recreation, education and inspiration.



## Interpretive Installations

Installations and signage can educate trail users about the history of the trail, local ecology or environmental concerns.



## Bicycle Parking and Water Fountains

Water fountains along the trail keep people and pets refreshed and hydrated. Bike racks can be purely functional, or works of art!



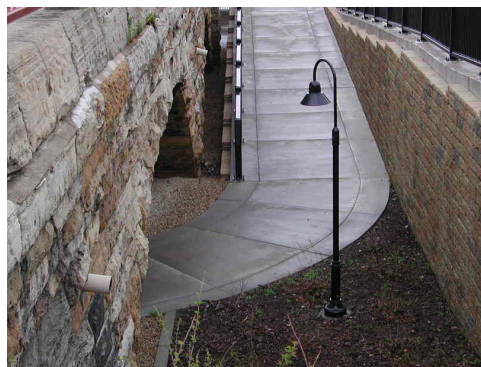
## Art Installations

Local artists can create art for the trail system, providing a unique experience for users. Many art installations are functional as well as aesthetic, places to sit and play.



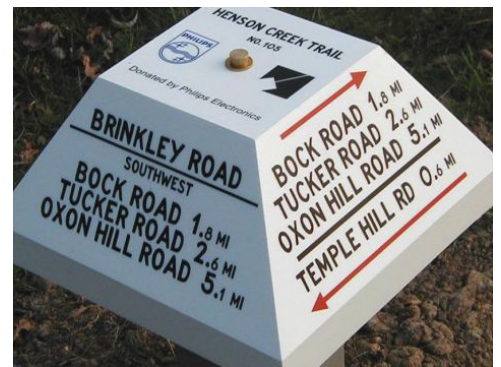
## Furniture

Providing benches at rest areas and viewpoints encourages people of all ages and capabilities to use the trail. Bench design can be simple (wood slats) or more ornate (stone, wrought iron, concrete).



## Pedestrian-Scale Lighting

Lighting enhances the aesthetic of the trail, improves safety, and enables the trail to be used year-round. Fixtures can be consistent with other light fixtures in the city, or emulate a historic theme



## Maps and Signage

A comprehensive signing system makes a trail system stand out. Informational kiosks with maps at trailheads and other pedestrian generators can provide enough information for someone to use the trail system with little introduction – perfect for areas marked for tourism, as well as local citizens.
